Seymour – May 18- Sunday turned out to be a perfect night for racing at the Seymour Speedway, with no wind and temps in the low 60's. 111 cars checked in to do battle on the 1/3 mile banked clay oval.

The Turbo Blue Street Stocks were up first with Alan Schlueter pacing the opening lap before Ryan Blank took charge. Blank started to pull away as the race for second heated up. Jeff Jungwirth, Patti Winkler, Jerry Winkler and Schlueter all watched as Blank built a lead until a lone caution flew on lap 9 and bunched the field.

Blank had his hands full over the next six laps as Jerry Winkler with Patty and Derek Lecker running hard for the runner up spot. Winkler pulled right behind the leader and put heavy pressure on, but Blank was able to maintain the top spot.

As the pack came out of turn 4 to get the white flag, Winkler was able to slip inside and be scored as the leader.

Over the final lap, Winkler was able to pull away for his second straight feature win at Seymour this season.

Blank was able to hold off Patti Winkle and Lecker to be scored in second, with defending champion, Jonny Ashcraft taking fifth and Jeff Dorschner making the top six.

Tony Wedelstadt grabbed the lead at the start of the Budweiser IMCA Modified main followed by T.J. Smith, John Berna, Mike Mullen, Sean Jerovetz and Eric Arneson. Marcus Yarie came through traffic to move in third on lap 11 and slowly picked his way into the runner up spot

with three laps remaining.

The lone caution of the race appeared then, and set up a three lap dash to the finish.
